AAAEA-DFW 2023 Scholarship Application

Eligibility

- 1. Scholarships are limited to students registered in STEM program at one of the Dallas Fort Worth metroplex universities or community colleges.
- 2. Scholarships are limited to students of an Arab descent. Otherwise, candidates will be evaluated equally regardless of race, creed, sex, religion, national origin, or any other basis.
- 3. Applicants can be resident or international students, graduate or undergraduate.
- 4. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.9 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent at the time of application.
- 5. Newly-enrolled students (first semester) need to submit transcripts of past highest degree.

Application Procedure

Applications must be completed, with all needed documents attached and **compiled to a single PDF file** and sent to <u>aaaea.dfw@gmail.com</u> by the application deadline.

- For continuing students: Current unofficial transcripts with GPA.
- For newly-enrolled students: High School/latest degree transcript with GPA
- One-page resume.
- Personal statement (one to two paragraphs why did you choose a STEM degree?).

Completed applications with all documents must be sent as a single PDF file no later than 5 p.m. on Nov 5, 2023.
